The City of Derry Airport is in the North West region of Northern Ireland, just 7 miles outside Londonderry, Northern Ireland's second largest city with a population of over 100,000 people.

In 1994, £10.5m was spent upgrading the facilities at the City of Derry airport with the construction of a new terminal, access roads, fire station, runway and lighting.
